

# European Solidarity Corps Volunteer Role Description



Hope is a Bournemouth charity providing housing, training and support for 98 homeless adults. Our residents are extremely vulnerable but our vision is to empower them to rebuild their lives; we help them to overcome issues such as trauma, addiction and poverty through counselling, sports, music and art. We also deliver essential items to the homeless throughout Dorset via our Hope AOK Rucksack Appeal, which is run voluntarily by our own residents.

We have recently created a Community Interest Company called Hope & More, where we produce and sell Hope Soap and run projects like the Bike Project and AOK Rucksack Appeal. We have also just obtained a shop which we hope to refurbish and open in January 2021 alongside an online shop.

Opportunities include supporting the online and offline launch of Hope & More, helping in the main office with administration and resident queries and helping our Health & Wellbeing Support Worker with any sports or health activities he may be organising.
